THINGS TO PRAY FOR

- Please do not talk loudly, answer your cellphone, or distract those here to pray. If you need to talk longer, please go outside.
- Please do not eat in the prayer room.
- Please keep drinks in spill-proof containers.
- Please clean up any spills and leave a message on our office phone at [619-286-3251](tel:619-286-3251) regarding any issues with the room.
- Please do not move any sound equipment or take anything from the prayer room
- The prayer room has no thermostat access or bathroom access (except during corporate gatherings).

VISITOR GUIDELINES

- No sleeping is allowed in the prayer room
- The prayer room is not a benevolence ministry and has no resources available for housing or meals. Please refer any benevolence requests to our office receptionist during regular business hours.
- Our prayer room code is to be given to members of All Peoples Church only.

PRAYER MINISTRY GUIDELINES

- If an official All Peoples meeting is not being held, please only use the room for private prayer.
- During private prayer please use a quiet voice as not to disturb others.
- Corporate prayer meetings will be led by members of the All Peoples Prayer Room Leadership Team only.
- Please be respectful of others, ask permission before laying hands in prayer, and use appropriate same gender boundaries during prayer ministry.
- Please do not bring outside musical instruments into the prayer room unless asked to do so for a corporate meeting.
- Please keep music volume at a comfortable and safe level.

ESPECIALLY FOR CHILDREN

- There is a special place for prayer set aside for children in the right corner of the room.
- Anyone under 18 must be accompanied and supervised by an adult at all times.
- Parents, please clean up any art supplies used by your child before departure.

EMERGENCIES
