Additional Information:

Visitation: Desert Days is a closed camp. This is for the safety and enjoyment of every camper.

Clothing: All clothing should be modest. Nothing too tight, too loose, too low or too high.

Cell Phones: In order to protect the full camp experience and your student's valuables, cell phones must be kept in cabins at all times.

Contacting your Camper: Campers will only have their phones accessible during the "Free Time" period each day or following Main Session.

Emergencies: A nurse will be on-site for the duration of the camp. Please contact Nick Taylor at 619-540-5272 in the case of an emergency.

Money & Shopping: Your child will not need any cash for purchasing. Desertland is an all-inclusive camp.

Dietary Needs: We are concerned about your child's health and will gladly work with you, if able, regarding dietary restrictions. Please contact us with any dietary needs or restrictions your child may have, and please notify these restrictions under "Food/Medication Allergies" on your child's registration form.

Medications: Medications brought must be in the original packaging with a label displaying the child's name. If your child requires a rescue inhaler or an EPI pen, please be sure that they are packed and available. Your child's camp room leader will need to have access to these in the event of an emergency.

Safety: Please also be assured that your child's safety and wellness is of the utmost importance to our staff. Every adult staff member will be background checked and trained prior to camp and campers will never be alone in a private situation with an adult.
